

Looking forward to a brand new Resource Centre

Work has started on the first phase of our new Resource Centre beside Richard Hardie's garage in Ashington. A £1.4million project, Phase 1 will provide more suitable premises for older people close to Ashington town centre. With a multi-purpose room, meeting space, smaller sessional rooms and a café, we will be creating new facilities for the community. Supported by the European Regional Development Fund and Coalfields Regeneration Trust (among others), we hope that Phase 1 of the Centre will be open in summer 2007.

We are now fundraising for Phase 2 of the Centre and would like to start building work in early 2008. Phase 2 will offer a gym for people aged 50+, a lounge, multi-purpose kitchen, dining / arts and crafts room, computer training suite and rooms for delivery of foot care and complementary therapies. Some storage and office accommodation will be available for community groups and other voluntary organisations.
